

Development Officer

The Battery Conservancy (TBC) is seeking an innovative, creative, and experienced Development Officer. A fast-paced, breaking the mold organization, TBC is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation that partners with the City of New York's Department of Parks & Recreation to maintain, operate, and program The Battery, the 25-acre public park at the southern tip of Manhattan, with annual foot traffic of more than 44 million.

The Development Officer will participate in all Conservancy fundraising efforts, with particular focus on grant management, including identifying prospects, writing letters of interest, applications, and reports. Other responsibilities include corporate donor cultivation and managing TBC's Raiser's Edge database.

A key player in the President's fundraising efforts, the Development Officer will have excellent writing skills to assist with marketing and communications. They will prepare materials and presentations for donor meetings. The ideal candidate will have experience and ability with graphic design.

The Development Officer must have the interpersonal skills to interact with TBC stakeholders, including government officials, trustees, donors, press, park visitors, TBC staff, and volunteers.
